Planning forms part of the process for ensuring there are opportunities available for you on leaving school. Planning will help identify the most appropriate offer that matches your needs and career aspirations. It must be:

- at the right level
- accessible both in terms of location and local labour market opportunity
- delivered through the right learning method
- fit with your chosen pathway

This questionnaire will form part of the transition planning process that will help to ensure an offer is in place in advance of your planned date for leaving full time education. It could include:

- modern apprenticeship or other training programme
- attending college or university
- volunteering
- employment

Schools are at the heart of post-16 transition planning. They are, therefore, well placed to facilitate the process required to help young people make and take up effective post-16 learning choices. This will involve a range of partners and agreed approaches, building on existing good practice and established relationships.
