

No One Left Behind (including the Young Person's Guarantee)

Dumfries & Galloway's Local Employability and Skills Partnership (LEP) will be commissioning through the national <u>Flexible Dynamic Purchasing System (DPS)</u> for the provision of Employability Services in Dumfries and Galloway to deliver No One Left Behind including the Young Person's Guarantee.

In this transitional year this <u>Flexible Dynamic Purchasing System (DPS)</u> will run alongside local commissioning arrangements and provision in order to complement existing contractual and procurement arrangements.

To ensure delivery is meeting the needs of service users and can provide the right support, at the right time and in the right way, we need a mixed economy of local service delivery across third, private and public sector providers.

The Local Employability and Skills Partnership encourages all local providers to register a 'Request to Participate' in Dumfries and Galloway by submitting a Single Procurement Document (SPD) and all documentation required as well as defining the service category:

- Engagement, Assessment, Action Planning, Case Management and Progression (including end-to-end Key Worker Support)
- Barrier Removal
- Vocational & Accredited Activity
- Employer Engagement, Advice & Support

To participate in the first phase of commissioning you must submit a 'Request to Participate' by the **17**^{th of} **March 2022**
