Agriculture Pre Apprenticeship

Three Week Induction (out with 26-week work placement) Successful applicants undertake a three-week induction period starting in June which will involve a range of activities including training and industry related visits.

The Work Placement

After the three-week induction, Pre-Apprentices take up their placement with a predetermined mentor. The work placement is fully paid, 40 hrs per week on a farm or suitable rural business. Up to £1500 of training will be offered to each candidate.

Graduation

Once the Pre-Apprentices have completed their 26-week placement, there will be a graduation ceremony where they will receive their certificate of completion awarded by Tarff
