Centre

- Registers pupils

Assessors



- Relationship with Host and Candidate

Work-based Learning



- Provides work placement to enable student to achieve the work placement modules
- Provides student with a mentor/buddy 1 day a week on site/farm

Coordinator



- Manages mentors

Student



- Attend work placement one day a week.
- Keep a record of skills developed and provide evidence.
