





## Young Person's Guarantee – Partnership Working Opportunity

- Do we need to achieve all the expected outcomes on the table?
  Not necessarily. We would expect emphasis on some outcomes more than others. This will depend on barriers faced and the nature of the group of young people you propose to support.
  - 2. Due to our intensive support system our numbers may be lower than what would possibly be expected but the impact is large. Is this ok?

As long as that is explained in your application the selection panel will take that into consideration.

3. Could we please have a chat about instruction sheet where in part 2 it talks about increasing the number of young people engaging in learning and skills development which doesn't seem to be on the outcome table unless this is reflected in the supported activity level or formal volunteering programme.

No problem - this wording has come directly from Scottish Government but our assumption is that gaining qualifications, commencing a formal activity programme, progressing to vocational training or entering FE/HE all contribute to increasing the number of young people engaging in learning and skills development,

4. Can you confirm re the 26-week support continued after getting into employment. Is this expected to be carried out by us or will this part be taken up in partnership with E&S?

This will be in partnership with E&S if clients move into a destination where the 26-week point extends beyond the funding but would be part of the role for those young people who secure a destination, where the 26 weeks is within the term.
